

## Standard Operating Procedure—State Financial Support for District Meets

After paying required fees to the Michigan Interscholastic Horsemanship Association (MIHA), districts will be reimbursed as follows.

### Junior Season:

\$500 flat rate reimbursement will be provided to any district hosting one or more junior meet.

### High School Season:

\$750 reimbursement will be provided to districts registering 1-30 riders.

\$2000 reimbursement will be provided to districts registering 31-74 riders.

\$2500 reimbursement will be provided to districts registering 75-100 riders.

\$3000 reimbursement will be provided to districts registering 101+ riders.

The MIHA Executive Board encourages districts to work together to combine resources and cut costs when prudent. The MIHA Board of Directors has the authority to review, combine, and/or dissolve districts as described in Article VIII, section B, of the MIHA Constitution and Bylaws. Beginning with 2024 data, districts with high school rider registration at or below 30 for at least three out of four consecutive years will be evaluated, with additional action likely to be taken.
