Coaches, congratulations on your District win and good luck to you at Regionals!

You will be attending Region A, held at the Berrien County Youth Fairgrounds (bcyf.org) in Berrien Springs, MI on September 26th-28th.

Attending Region A will be Districts 3, 5, 15, and 16. Teams will compete over three days; the top **two** scoring teams in each division will advance to the State competition in Midland, MI - October 8th to the 12th.

When you arrive, you will need to pay Candice (D5) for all registration, camping and stall fees. Candice will have a copy of what you have reserved, T-Shirts you have pre-ordered, back numbers, camper passes and give you a receipt in the office Friday afternoon.

Please complete this prior to the Coaches meeting at 12:00p.m.

Each rider will get 2 back numbers.

Patterns for Showmanship, Equitation, and Trail can be located on the website www.MIHA.org on Monday September 15th.. Remember all riding classes (including bareback) will have a pattern.

The Regional committee will hold a **Mandatory** coach meeting at 12:00pm Friday afternoon (bleachers On the Julie Hein Ring) to help get questions answered for coaches/teams.

Region A Registration Information

- All stalls must be cleaned completely to the ground before leaving, confirm with DC before departure.
- All horses spending the night must be stalled by 9pm.
- Please do not bring horses that are not showing
- Camping includes 1 electric hook up and access to water. (fill your water tank, do NOT hook up to spigot for the weekend)
- Dump station is available.
- Shavings - limited supply available at the meet; no guarantee shavings will be available if not ordered.
- T-shirts: Can be pre-ordered on your registration form or purchased during the meet (while supplies last - limited availability).

Gates Open: 8:00 am Friday, September 26, 2025

Enter at Gate #3 - Please do not try to enter early; if you do, you will be charged a penalty fee.

Registration/show office will be open 8:00 am (Friday), 8:30am-7:00p.m (Saturday) and 8:30am- 1hour after the show ends on Sunday).

Coaches should check in at the office to pay fees, receive back numbers, T-shirts, and camping permits.

Stall assignments will be posted by Thursday at 6:00p.m.

Only coaches and assistant coaches are allowed to come to the office for information or make changes during the meet.

Stalls will be assigned in barns 46-52 and posted in the barns and at the entry office by 6:00pm Thursday. Districts may or may not be stalled together, depending on team sizes and number of horses being stalled.

- Campers may park behind/east of the horse barns or south of the committee campers(see map).
- **Locations will be assigned by the District** and a camping permit must be displayed in the window by 10a.m. on Saturday.
- Please be considerate of your neighbors.
- Do not block in other campers by parking your vehicle in your camping area. You may unload your belongings into your camper, but please do NOT block other campsites with your vehicles.
- Please do not block the rear and front of the barns with empty vehicles as well. If you have unloaded your vehicle, please kindly get it out of the way so others may do the same.
- Fair employees will do a count! Please do not park in emergency/fire lanes or fair employees will move you. **If you are unsure, please ask. Be courteous to your neighbors.**

Mandatory Judges/Coaches Meetings (at the top of the grandstands):

- Friday, September 26th at 12:00 pm (noon)
- Saturday, September 27th at 8:00a.m
- Sunday, September 28th at 8:00am

8:30 a.m. Saturday – Presentation of teams in Ring 1, Jack Dean Ring.

- Bring your team banner if you have one. Teams will be announced in this order:
- D teams: D3, D5, D15, D16
- C teams: D3, D5, D15, D16
- B teams: D3, D5, D15, D16
- A teams: D3, D5, D15, D16
- Please line up outside the indoor show arena in that order. This is a good opportunity for a team picture.

We will have time for judge's questions at the end of each day if you need something clarified.

Camping Rules for Region A

- Campers may come in on Thursday between 3pm-8pm; they will be charged.
- Each campsite is required to have a responsible adult (18 or older) staying with the group each night.
- All who stay the night will be charged as a camper. (no tents) No sleeping in the barns or outbuildings.
- No alcoholic beverages or non-prescription drugs will be allowed. Violators will be removed and may face prosecution. This is a YOUTH event.
- Any camper, member, or camping group, who violates any rule, will have their camping permit revoked. They will be required to remove their camper from the grounds immediately, or it will be removed at the owner's expense. Camping fees will be forfeited, and camping parties will not be allowed back without approval from the Show committee.
- Once horses are unloaded, they should not be in the Camping area or tied to horse trailers.
- Ground Fires are not allowed. Fires must be contained and controlled.
- NO SMOKING except in designated parking areas or within camp site.
- Please keep your area picked up and free of trash. The premises must be left clean and orderly.
- Dump station is available.

Pet Policy

- Pets must be inside campers, restrained on their own camp lot or always leashed with leash in hand.
- Pets MUST stay in camper village, NO Exceptions. If you need a clarification on where the camping area is, please ask at the office. This includes visitors coming in to observe the show.
- **Pets are NOT to be in or around the horse barns, arenas, bathrooms or showers.**
- Pets MUST be cleaned up after and waste properly disposed of.
- Any violations - no warnings are given and you will be asked to remove your pet from the fairgrounds.

Lunch will be served for all Judges, Ringmasters, Announcers, and office workers in the show office.
Dinner will also be served on Friday and Saturday.

MIHA Region A Meet Rules

- No riding faster than a walk or lunging outside of the Rings.
- There are three large practice rings that can be used plus two round pens.
- No riding in the rings if someone is in that ring lunging. Lunging is to be completed by 7am in the show and make-up arenas; after 7am the round pens will be available for lunging.
- NO RIDING IN THE ROUND PENS.
- Proper footwear (heeled boots); headgear (when jumping) and tack must be worn during all riding.
- No tank tops, no halter-tops, t-shirt minimum required, or 3 finger rule applies to tank tops, sports bras, and 3" inseam for shorts. No tennis shoes.
- No riding with halters and lead ropes. Proper riding equipment only.
- No riding after dark unless competing.
- If you load or unload in front of the barns, please make it as quick as possible then move the trailer to avoid traffic congestion.
- No parking in front of barns. No loading or unloading in front of barns during competition.
- No cursing in or out of the rings. This is considered unsportsmanlike and could cost your team to lose points and/or be dismissed from competition.
- Participants and parents are expected to be courteous to all show volunteers and fairgrounds crew. Any unsportsmanlike conduct will result in loss of points or removal from the grounds.
- Stalls and Tack stalls must be cleaned to the ground before departure. Stalls not cleaned will be charged to your team (\$20). Your DC must check your stalls before leaving.
- NO SMOKING except in designated parking areas or within camp sites.

Coaches

- All your team members and their parents, trainers or friends are your responsibility.
- If a problem arises during competition only a coach may bring it to the office or directly to your District Chairman.
- Nobody goes to the Judge.
- One warning will be given.
- The next infraction, the person will be asked to leave the grounds for the day of competition.
- If the person does not comply, all points for said team for that day of competition will be forfeited.
- Check your rule book for proper ways to protest.
